ABOUT THE CENTER AM POTSDAMER PLATZ

In October 2017, Oxford Properties Group partnered with Madison International Realty to acquire the mixed-use asset, still known as "Sony Center am Potsdamer Platz" at the time. Since July 2022, Norges Bank Investment Management has joined Oxford Properties Group as a new partner with a 50 percent stake. Built in 2000 to designs by renowned architect Helmut Jahn, the Center is a 113,000-square-meter mixed-use complex at Potsdamer Platz in the heart of Berlin. The Center Potsdamer Platz spans neaerly six acres and includes eight buildings, including the BahnTower, 85,000 square metres of prime office space, 20,000 square metres for retail and leisure, and 67 residential units. The modern architectural icon is now a landmark of Berlin and attracts over seven million visitors a year. The main tenants of the Center include Deutsche Bahn and WeWork.

The naming rights cooperation with Sony ended on March 31, 2023. Henceforth, the building will no longer bear the name "Sony Center am Potsdamer Platz". Until the official re-naming, which will take place on the occasion of the re-opening of the center post construction in summer 2024, the building will temporarily be called "The Center Potsdamer Platz".

What will change by 2025? The Center will undergo a repositioning and transformation process of its architecture and landscape design as well as its F&B and retail offerings. The Masterplan will include architectural changes to all eight buildings. Additionally, landscaping and a complete redesign of the lower level and ground floor retail and restaurants will also take place. Berlin's most inspiring office campus destination is created here, bringing people, commerce and culture together under one famous roof.
